## FLYNN'S WINES *Site 15*

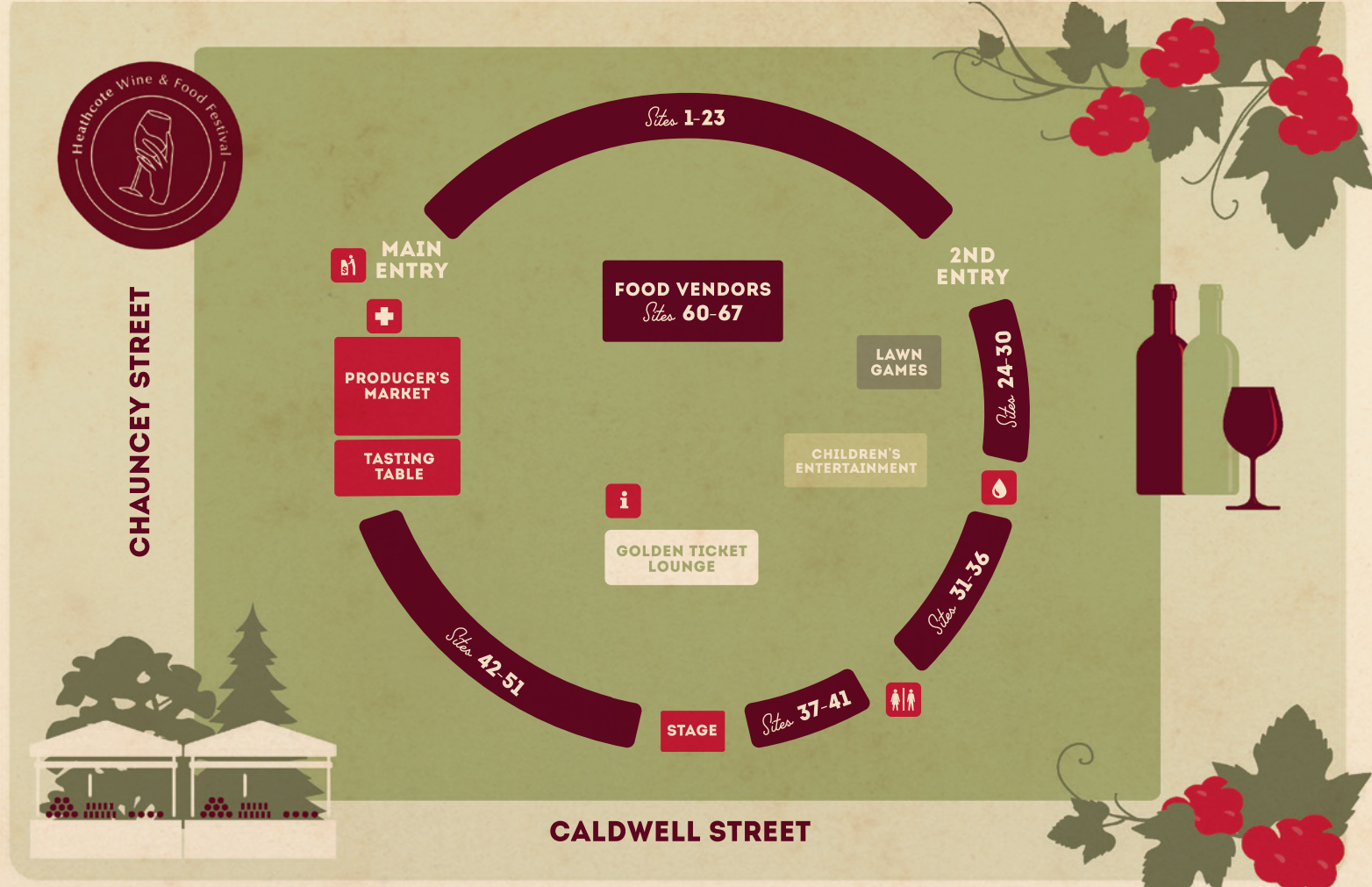
